- Whenex a Whit Petition (C) No.500 of 3020 was filed in the Hon ble Supreme Court of India section in furthwith been on spraying of all kinds of disinfectants on human beings using any medality meloding disinfectant tunnels exposing human beings to ultraviole rays for the purposes districting them as a measure towards Covid-19 management.
- Whereas, as per directions of Flon ble Supreme Court in the above writ Petition, this Ministry vide O.M. No. Z-21020/159/2020-PH dated 23/09/2020, wrote to all the State/UT governments that spraying of malividuals with disinfectants using various modalities is not/recommended and direct to ensure that such practices are not implemented in the States/UTs:
- Whereas, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the Judgment dated 05.11.2020, has ordered the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (i) to consider and issue necessary direction in exercise of powers vested in it under Disaster Management Aut. 2005 regarding ban/ regulation on the use of discrection tunnels involving spraying or femigation of chemical/organic disinfectants on human beings, or (ii) exposure of human beings to artificial ultraviolet my
- Now, therefore, in pursuant to the aforementioned order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in W.P.(C) No 560 of 2020 and in exercise of powers delegated under Section 10(2) of the Disester menagement Act. 2005 vide Ministry of Home Affairs Order No. 40-2/2020-DM-ItA1 dated 11.103 2030, the matter has been considered and it is hereby directed that the States and Ucnon Territory Administration shall ensure that usage of disinfectants on human beings involving spraying or furnisation or any other modulity shall not be done. The matter of usage of artificial ultraviolet mys is being deliberated & after due deliberations appropriate directions will be issued.
- The Chief Secretary of the States/UTs should ensure compliance of this order by all concerned. violation of which will be treated as an offence under the Disaster Management Act rend with the individualist institutions authorities. accordingly against defaulting
